# OPEN CALL FOR (SOCIO-)CULTURAL PARTNERS September 2021 - March 2022



#### THE PROJECT

"Homelands, places of belonging" is a co-creation community project for and by newcomer artists, initiated by the International Yehudi Menuhin Foundation and its partners. After a successful start in 2018, a third edition is now on its way!



#### HOW?

Each edition a newcomer artist forms an artistic tandem with a (socio-) cultural center and during 15 sessions or 45 hours spread over a period of 6 months they launch an artistic and co-creative journey with a group of citizens that will lead to a show, exhibition, concert,...

The theme of each project is related to the mission of the project: what does it mean to feel at home or to belong to something (a city, a neighborhood, a generation, ...)



#### **TRAININGS & COACHING?**

To strengthen the quality of their work, professional coaching and training in co-creation is planned along the way for the pairs (artist-cultural mediator) and under the guidance of international experts of the foundation: A 5-day residency and 2 days of training.



#### **WHAT'S NEXT?**

For the third edition, which will take place between the end of September 2021 and the middle of March 2022, the project will be opened to new cultural partners. You want to be one of them? You want to know more? Let's talk!
